RENU GUPTA, MD AND NAVIN GUPTA 2026 Clifford H. Goldsmith Award Recipients



Thousands of miles away, India was the birthplace for both Renu and Navin Gupta. For different reasons, life would take these teenagers to Zambia, where they would meet, marry, and begin their lives together.

In 1980, Renu and Navin found their way to Philadelphia to pursue their careers in medicine and engineering, respectively. Shortly thereafter, they became parents to Meruka, Kernika, and Ankur. In the early 1990s, Navin's eldest sister, Indu, was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis. Indu had a decades-long, fearless, and valiant battle with MS, which she tragically succumbed to in 2013.

In May 2001, while Meruka was a freshman at NYU, she also received a diagnosis of MS. Renu immediately thought of her colleague, Fred Lublin, who was serendipitously moving from Philadelphia to New York City, to lead the MS program at Mount Sinai. Renu knew that Fred would provide unparalleled, excellent care for their daughter, and this has proven to be true time and again, these past 25 years.

Since its inception, Renu and Navin have been steadfast supporters of the CGD Center, in addition to the National MS Society, and numerous other charitable organizations within their local community and globally. Their commitment to bettering the lives of all is evidenced by their quiet, steadfast approach.

The C. Olsten Wellness Program at Mount Sinai

People living with multiple sclerosis (MS) need more than the latest medications to thrive. Social needs, physical activity, mental health support, nutrition, and stress management all need to be part of the game plan. And because these needs are impossible to meet within the structure of routine office visits, The C. Olsten Wellness Program was conceived and launched. Since 2020, the Wellness Program strives to provide truly comprehensive, patient-centered care to those living with MS. Our goal is to be the “village,” the support system that our patients need to thrive.

The Wellness Program provides access to one-on-one counseling with nurse practitioners, dietitians, physical therapists, and social workers. All these services are available virtually by smartphone, tablet, or computer. In addition, we have collaborated with a virtual exercise platform to provide our participants with at-home workouts specifically for MS patients. Each patient is provided a personalized plan that will help them to live their life as fully as possible.

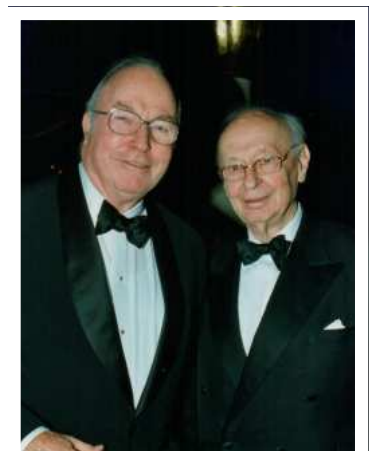
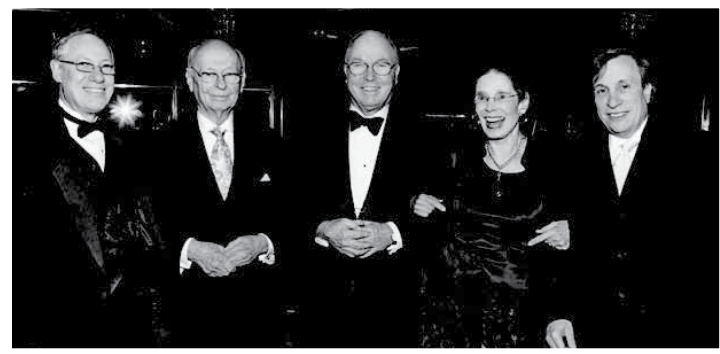
