Our goal now in transforming the Tisch Cancer Hospital into a space where the unparalleled clinical care we provide is coupled with a state-of-the-art, serene environment is to support recovery at every turn — through thoughtful design that integrates nature into care, invites patients' support systems to be a continuous part of their loved ones' journeys, and extends ample amenities to bring ease to the patient experience.

When the new Tisch Cancer Hospital opens its doors, we will further demonstrate the highest level of comprehensive and personalized care by attending specifically to the specialized needs that come with a cancer diagnosis. From private, light-filled patient rooms to a rejuvenating apheresis unit that makes cell therapy approachable, and from spaces as critical as a cancer-specific urgent care unit to those that have the capacity to make a mark on patients' memories — like a salon and spa — all of these design elements and more will be found in one place, redefining health care in an urban setting. We hope you will be a part of this transformation by considering making a gift to the following components of this visionary hospital, for which naming opportunities are available at the designated levels.

Patient Floor (multiple opportunities): \$15 million

Each of four patient floors will comprise approximately 20 private, single-bed rooms and be designed around the concept of family-centered care, which allows loved ones to participate in patients' recovery and is known to lead to tangibly improved outcomes. One floor will be a designated intensive care unit, and all other floors will have the potential to be converted into an intensive care unit as needed.

Urgent Care Unit: \$10 million

A 24-hour oncology urgent care unit on the first floor will provide an alternative to the standard emergency room, connecting patients with the care they need quickly, safely, and with minimal stress. Patients may be treated and released or admitted to rooms upstairs.

Sky Garden: \$5 million

A two-story atrium and sky garden will offer patients and their families the opportunity to rest and enjoy time in nature, which is proven to have calming physiological effects.

Family Center: \$5 million

When patients have longer stays, we take care of their loved ones too with a dedicated space for respite and refreshment.

Wellness Spa: \$5 million

To complement patient care, the Wellness Spa will nourish the spirits of our patients with longer stays, helping them to heal from within.

Apheresis Unit: \$3 million

This dedicated space will make the time-consuming process of apheresis — by which blood is withdrawn, circulated through a machine to remove components, and infused back into the body — more relaxing. Apheresis is essential to many patients' recovery; for example, stem cells can be collected from the blood and reintroduced following a bone marrow transplant.

Elevator Bank: \$2 million

A prominent focal point, this is one of the first impressions patients, families, and visitors will have of the hospital they will frequent.

Family Living Room (multiple opportunities): \$2 million

We will transform traditional waiting areas into comforting sanctuaries for the family members and friends whose support makes all the difference in the journey from diagnosis to recovery.

Discharge Lounge: \$2 million

This private area gives discharged patients a space to comfortably wait for a ride.

Interdisciplinary Room (multiple opportunities): \$1 million

These two multi-purpose rooms may be used for yoga, workshops, and other activities that support patients in their recovery process.

Conservatory and Meditation Room: \$1 million

Filled with natural light, this room will serve as a tranquil place where patients can center and reconnect with themselves away from the hospital environment.

Hair Spa: \$1 million

A key feature of our wellness facilities, the Hair Spa helps address what we so often hear is one of the hardest lifestyle adjustments of cancer treatment.

Wellness Room (multiple opportunities): \$500,000

The Wellness Rooms can be used for acupuncture, Reiki energy healing, and other integrative care modalities that reduce pain and support patient well-being.

Consult Room (multiple opportunities): \$500,000

Consult Rooms will provide spaces for families and care teams to share information, discuss treatment plans, and partner together in support of patients.

Command Center (multiple opportunities): \$500,000

Command Centers will optimize collaboration among teams of highly trained doctors, nurses, and support staff, enhancing the care coordination that is so vital to successful treatment.

Staff Lounge (multiple opportunities): \$500,000

These spaces will help clinicians to find true rest when they need it, so they can function at their best.

Inpatient Room (multiple opportunities): \$250,000

All patient rooms will be private, reflecting the highest level of attention and care to every patient. Each room will also have a window to let in natural light and spaces for family members to spend time. As does every floor, every room will have the capacity to accommodate intensive care should the need arise, and fully ADA-accessible patient rooms will be available on four floors.
